1. <u>Purchase of graves</u>		
a. For the purchase of exclusive right of burial in an earthen grave	£300	£600
b. For the purchase of exclusive right in a Cremation plot	£150	£300
c. For the purchase of exclusive right in the 'Green' burial area	£300	£600
d. For the grant of the right to the Commonwealth War Graves Commission.	Free	Free

Exclusive right of burial in a purchased grave expires after 75 years, when the right may be purchased for a further period. It is incumbent on the owners of the grave to keep it in a good condition.		
2. <u>Walled Graves</u>		
For the right to construct a walled grave and purchase of exclusive right	£500	£1000
3. <u>Interments</u>		
a. For the interment of a coffin in an earthen grave at single depth.	£175	£350
b. For the interment of coffin(s) in an earthen grave at double depth.	£200	£400
c. Fee for interment of coffin (s) in an earthen grave at treble depth.	£225	£450
d. For the interment of a person whose age at the time of death did not exceed 16 years.	Free	£100
e. For the interment of cremated remains in a burial plot.	£75	£150
f. For the interment of cremated remains in a cremation plot.	£100	£200
g. For the interment of a coffin/shroud in an earthen grave in the green area single depth	£175	£350
h. For the interment of a coffin/shroud in an earthen grave in the green area double depth	£ 200	£400
i. For the interment of a coffin/shroud in an earthen grave in the green area double depth	£ 225	£450
j. For the scattering of ashes	£40	£80
k. For the body of a still born child.	Free	Free
The coffin is to be constructed in accordance with the requirements of the relevant current regulations.		
4. <u>Headstones</u>		
For the right to erect a headstone on a grave in respect of which the exclusive right of burial has been granted.		
a. Headstone (grave only) including the first inscription	£150	£300
b. Ledger stone (grave only) including the first inscription	£175	£350
c. Tablet (cremation plot only) including the first inscription	£ 75	£150
d. Subsequent inscriptions	£ 50	£ 50
5. <u>Search Fees</u> (Within 15 years)	£ 40	

6. Definition

For the purpose of these charges non resident is a person who does not reside in the Parish, but, if he or she has left the Parish within the past 12 months or has removed to a Residential/Nursing Home with the past 10 years or where there is a second or third interment where the grave space was purchased, then the interment will be considered to be the same as for residents.

7. Regulation regarding memorials

Headstones must not exceed 36 inches high, 24 inches wide and 4 inches deep. The plinth must not exceed 30 inches long 12 inches wide and 9 inches deep. Headstones may not be placed on Cremation plots. Tablets must not exceed 21 inches square and must be flush with the grass. Tablets are only for cremation plots.

To facilitate grass cutting, no surrounds are permitted, also no items, including plants, are to be placed on the grave other than at the headstone.

8. Times of Funerals

All funerals must take place between 9am and 4pm or 1¼ hours before sunset whichever is the earliest.

Grave digging is not permitted on Sundays or after dusk, this also applies to backfilling and all surplus spoil must be removed from the Cemetery.

No work in the Cemetery may proceed until the grave plot has been marked out by the Council, in addition the appropriate fees must have been paid in full and written authorisation received, duly signed by the Clerk.

All surplus spoil must be removed from the Cemetery.
