General Maintenance	General maintenance of vegetation, flower beds, footpaths, litter picking and weed control.	Injury to members of the public and burial contractors.	A contractor is appointed to maintain all green areas and footpaths. Weed killing is only to be carried out by	Low	Contractors to be made aware of any risk within the site.

Tree or branches falling	Working on trees with machinery, ladders and hoists including felling, pruning and lopping.	Injury to contractors, members of the public and the burial contractors.	<b>All trees to be maintained and inspected by an arborist if needed</b>	Low	Ongoing
Weather	Sun burn or cold wet conditions	Sun burn or hypothermia affecting contractors.	Contractors advised to wear suitable clothing, use sunscreen and keep well hydrated.	Low	
Uneven and/or slippery paths/surfaces	Slips, trips and falls	Injury to members of the public or contractors	Contracted grounds person to ensure all footpaths are kept clear of trip and slip hazards such as branches, dead leaves, moss, etc. Subsidence/re-levelling of individual plots will be checked periodically by the Parish Council. Tarmac driveway to be checked by PC for wear and tear/holes.	Low-Med	Create and install a safety notice about the hazards and the risks
Mole hills	Trips and falls	Injury to members of the public or contractors	Parish Council to check on mole activity at regular intervals. Mole catcher has been used in 2024	Low	Summer 2024 mole catcher appointed. 4 moles caught and removed

Litter	Disrespect of people not taking their own litter home (as requested)	Trip hazard, unpleasant mess, damage to wildlife.	All people are asked to take their litter home with them or to use the compost bins provided for non plastic.	Low	Sign already in place
Lone working	Accidents, aggression or intimidation from others	Psychological and physical injuries	All contractors are advised to carry a charged mobile phone with them. Any burial contractors to notify the Parish Council that they are to work alone in the cemetery and to contact the Police if they experience unwanted or aggressive behaviour from members of the public.	Low	Ongoing
Entrance gates	Heavy metal entrance gates	Damage to fingers, etc., or catching vehicle if not open properly.	Check hinges and closing mechanisms regularly and record results.	Low	Ongoing
Low hanging electrical cables from above	Electrical	Potentially dangerous to anyone entering/existing the cemetery	Visually check and report if concerned.	Medium	Ongoing
Cemetery benches x 2	Defects to wood or bench itself	Splinters, slip off, etc	Check for wear and tear and record	Low-Med	Ongoing
